Directions to the Park

The park is just off Parmer, north of 620. From the intersection of Parmer and 620, take Parmer north past 620 to Brushy Creek Road. (It is about 2 - 3 miles.) There will be a Shell gas station at the intersection. Turn right onto Brushy Creek Road. Turn right into the first park entrance and park in the first parking lot on the right.
